 - 2. Thursday, February 19: Matthew 3 – 4;** Micah 5:2; Micah 5:2 (Messiah would be born in Bethlehem.)
 - 3. Friday, February 20: Matthew 5 – 7; Isaiah 7:14** (Messiah would be born of a virgin.)
 - 4. Saturday, February:** 21 Matthew 8 – 9; Genesis 12:3; Genesis 12:3 (Messiah would be a descendant of Abraham.)

 - 11. Monday, March 2:** Matthew 24 – 25; Jeremiah 31:15 (A massacre of children would happen at Messiah's birth place.)
 - 12. Tuesday, March 3:** Matthew 26 – 28; Psalm 69:8 (Messiah would be rejected by his own people.)
 - 13. Wednesday, March 4:** Mark 1 – 3; Malachi 4:5,6 (Messiah would be preceded by Elijah.)

- 14. Thursday, March 5:** Mark 4 - 5; Psalm 2:7 (Messiah would be declared the Son of God.)
- 15. Friday, March 6: Mark 6 - 7;** Isaiah 11:1 (Messiah would be called a Nazarene.)
- 16. Saturday, March 7:** Mark 8 - 10; Isaiah 9:1-2 (Messiah would bring light to Galilee.)
- 17. Monday, March 9:** Mark 11 - 13; Psalm 78:2-4 (Messiah would speak in parables.)
- 18. Tuesday, March 10:** Mark 14 - 16; Isaiah 61:1-2 (Messiah would be sent to heal the brokenhearted.)
- 19. Wednesday, March 11:** Luke 1 - 2; Psalm 110:4 (Messiah would be a priest after the order of Melchizedek.)
- 20. Thursday, March 12:** Luke 3 - 4; Zechariah 9:9 (Messiah would be called King.)
- 21. Friday, March 13:** Luke 5 - 6; Psalm 8:3 (Messiah would be praised by little children.)
- 22. Saturday, March 14:** Luke 7; Psalm, 41:9 (Messiah would be betrayed.)
- 23. Monday, March 16:** Luke 8 - 9; Zechariah 11:12,13 (Messiah's price money would be used to buy a potters field.)
- 24. Tuesday, March 17:** Luke 10 - 11; Isaiah 53:7 (Messiah would be silent before his accusers.)
- 25. Wednesday, March 18:** Luke 12 - 13; Isaiah 50:6 (Messiah would be spat upon and cursed.)
- 26. Thursday, March 19:** Luke 14 - 16; Psalm 35:19 (Messiah would be hated without cause.)

27. Friday, March 20: Luke 17 – 19; Isaiah 53:12 (Messiah would be crucified with criminals.)

28. Saturday, March 21: Luke 20 – 21; Psalm 69:21 (Messiah would be given vinegar to drink.)

29. Monday, March 23 Luke 22 – 24; Psalm 22:16 (Messiah's hands and feet would be pierced.)

30. Tuesday, March 24: John 1 – 2; Psalm 22:7,8 (Messiah would be mocked and ridiculed.)

31. Wednesday, March 25: John 3 – 4; Psalm 22:18 (Soldiers would gamble for Messiah's garments.)

32. Thursday, March 26: John 5 – 6; Psalm 34:20 (Messiah's bones would not be broken.)

33. Friday, March 27: John 7 – 8; Psalm 22:1 (Messiah would be forsaken by God.)

34. Saturday, March 28: John 9 – 10; Psalm 109:4 (Messiah would pray for his enemies.)

35. Monday, March 30: John 11 – 12; Zechariah 12:10 (Soldiers would pierce Messiah's side.)

36. Tuesday, March 31: John 13 – 14; Isaiah 53:9 (Messiah would be buried with the rich.)

37. Wednesday, April 1: John 15 – 16; Isaiah 53:4-12 (Messiah would be a sacrifice for sins.)

38. Thursday, April 2: John 17; Psalm 16:10 (Messiah would resurrect from the dead.)

39. Friday, April 3: John 18 – 19; Psalm 24:7-10 (Messiah would ascend to heaven.)

40. Saturday, April 4: John 20 – 21; Psalm 58:18 (Messiah would be seated at God's right hand.)
